Mission

The Hospice was created to respond to the healthcare, clinical, psychological and spiritual needs of cancer patients in advanced and terminal stages and to offer support to their family members.

The objective of the Hospice is to guarantee global assistance to the patient, personalizing care in order to ensure the patient's quality of life, while respecting their dignity.

The objectives it pursues are the following:

- integrate the home palliative care service for pain control and containment;
- temporarily lift the load families welfare;
- allow the sick, with short hospitalizations, to overcome crisis situations that are difficult to control at home and which do not require hospital stay;
- replace the house when the patient's house is not suitable or when the patient is alone;
- facilitate the continuity of emotional relationships;
- allow a "protected discharge" to home the resignation is agreed with the doctor General Medicine and with the assistance service home of the ASL company.



The Services

Palliative care provided in hospices represents an integrated, therapeutic and healthcare response to the needs of the patient and his family. They are aimed not only at treating the pain and symptoms that may appear in this phase of the disease but are aimed at "taking care" of the person, also from a psychological, social and spiritual point of view, with constant attention to everything that it can, and must be done, to improve their quality of life. Palliative care is in fact, according to the definition of the World Health Organization, "active care aimed at the physical, psychological, emotional, social and spiritual dimension of the patient and his family, with the aim of improving the quality of life by offering an comprehensive and effective to the needs of the sick person". This is why in Hospice care is centered on the patient and, respecting their values, has as its main objective that of giving meaning and meaning to every moment of their life.

In the Hospice, the care and assistance provided has the aim of controlling the symptoms that cause suffering and discomfort to the patient; the real priority becomes the one that the patient indicates to us by expressing her needs.
